### Planning

Make the most of your scraps with this colorful throw pillow. One side is made of assorted light/medium batiks and the other side of assorted dark/medium batiks, for a truly reversible pillow that can be flipped to match any mood.

Our instructions have you stuff your completed pillow with fiberfill. For extra fullness, you may prefer to use a 16" x 16" pillow form instead.

Assorted light/medium batiks (strips)  $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$  yd. **total**

Assorted dark/medium batiks (strips)  $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$  yd. **total**

Fiberfill\*

## Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)

Assorted light/medium batiks—cut a total of:

1 strip  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

1 strip  $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

2 strips  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

3 strips 2" x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

2 strips  $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

1 strip  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

Assorted dark/medium batiks—cut a total of:

1 strip  $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

2 strips 2" x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

1 strip  $1\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

3 strips  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

2 strips  $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

3 strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

## Piecing the Pillow Front and Back

- 1 Referring to **Diagram I**, stitch together assorted light/medium strips in order shown to make pillow front. Make 1. In similar manner, stitch together assorted dark/medium strips in order shown to make pillow back (**Diagram II**).

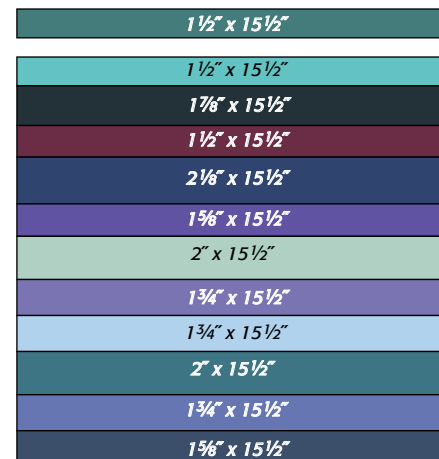
## Assembling the Pillow

- 2 Layer pillow front and back, right sides together and raw edges aligned (**Diagram III**). Be sure that seams are running the same direction on both front and back. Stitch around edges, pivoting at corners and leaving an opening on 1 side for turning. Turn right side out through opening; press.
- 3 Stuff with fiberfill and hand stitch opening closed.



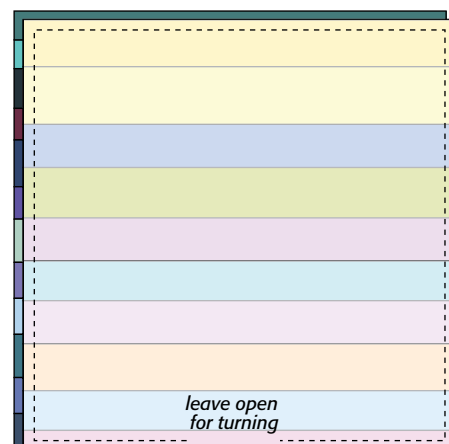
