



Crazy Anne Lap Quilt SUGGESTED LAYOUT Web-only Bonus Pattern

APPROXIMATE QUILT SIZE

50" x 62"

NUMBER OF BLOCKS AND FINISHED SIZE

12 Crazy Anne blocks - 12" x 12"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Cream ... 2 3/8 yards (includes inner border)
Green print ... 2 5/8 yards (includes outer border and binding)
Blue ... 5/8 yard
Mauve ... 1 yard (includes middle border)
Backing ... 3 1/2 yards
Batting ... Twin size

PLANNING

Crazy Anne blocks are pieced quick and accurately using the provided foundation guides. Cutting dimensions are given in the Cutting Instructions so you can precut your patches, a technique that speeds the process (see Precut **Pieces Placement Guide**, page 3). You'll notice that precut patches have excess seam allowance built into their size, and they're trimmed after seaming. When foundation piecing, set your sewing machine to a very short stitch length (12-15 stitches per inch). This perforates the paper as you stitch, making it easier to tear away when finished.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cream

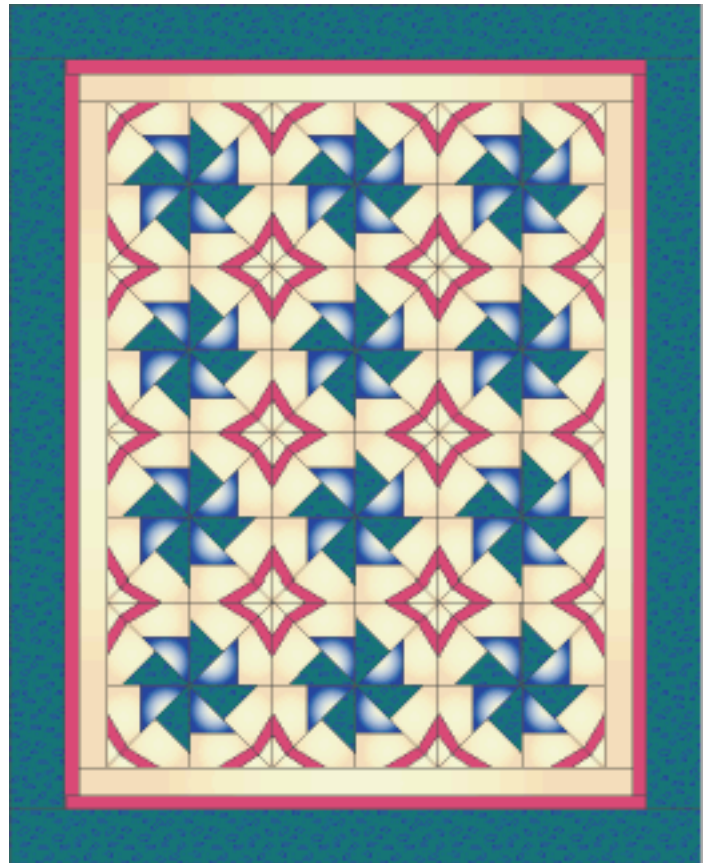
... 96 rectangles 1 3/4" x 3 3/4"
... 48 rectangles 3 3/4" x 4 3/4"
... 48 rectangles 3" x 5"
... 2 strips 2 1/2" x 52", pieced from 3 width of fabric (WOF) strips
... 2 strips 2 1/2" x 44", pieced from 2 WOF strips and lengths left over after piecing previous strips

Green print

... *2 strips 4 1/2" x 54", cut on lengthwise grain
... *2 strips 4 1/2" x 58", cut on lengthwise grain
... 12 squares 6 1/2" x 6 1/2", cut in half twice diagonally to make 48 quarter-square triangles

Blue

... 24 squares 4 3/4" x 4 3/4", cut in half once diagonally to make 48 half-square triangles



Mauve

... 96 rectangles 2 1/4" x 3 3/4"
... 2 strips 1 1/2" x 56", pieced from 3 WOF strips
... 2 strips 1 1/2" x 46", pieced from 3 WOF strips
... *Cut first

PIECING THE BLOCKS

1. Print out 48 Unit I and 48 Unit II Foundation Guides.
2. Referring to **Diagram I-A**, place fabric for area #1 (green print 6 1/2" quarter-square triangle) over area #1 on unprinted side of Unit I Foundation Guide. A dab of glue stick will hold fabric in place. Position fabric for area #2 (cream 3 1/4" x 5 1/2" rectangle) over area #2, right side up. Carefully flip fabric #2 onto fabric #1, placing right sides together (**I-B**). **Hint:** Hold foundation and fabric to light source for accurate placement. Holding #1 and #2 fabrics in place, turn foundation over so printed side is facing up. Stitch on the line separating areas #1 and #2 (**I-C**). Trim seam allowance to a scant 1/4" (**I-D**) and fingerpress fabric #2 outward (**I-E**).

3. In numerical order, add pre-cut fabrics to paper foundation unit following the technique in Step 2. Remember to place, sew, trim, and press. After foundation is completely sewn, cut along outer dashed line with scissors or rotary cutter (see **Diagram II**). Make 48 **Unit I** and 48 **Unit II** total (See **Diagram III**). Do not remove paper.

4. Referring to **Diagram IV**, stitch together **Unit I** and **Unit II** to make quadrant. Stitch together four quadrants to make Crazy Anne Block (See **Diagram V**). Remove foundation papers carefully. Make 12 Crazy Anne Blocks total.

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Note: Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps.

5. Sew 4 rows of 3 Crazy Anne Blocks each. Stitch rows together.

6. Stitch cream 2 1/2" x 52" strips to side; trim even with top and bottom. Sew remaining cream strips to top and bottom; trim even with sides. Stitch mauve 1 1/2" x 56" strips to sides; trim even with top and bottom. Sew remaining mauve strips to top and bottom; trim even with sides. Stitch green print 4 1/2" x 58" strips to side; trim even with top and bottom. Sew remaining green print strips to top and bottom; trim even with sides.

QUILTING AND FINISHING

7. Layer and baste quilt top for quilting method of your choice.

8. Bind quilt with green print fabric (see Quiltmaking Lessons <http://www.mccallsquilting.com/qquilts/lessons/>).

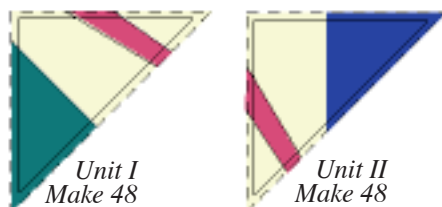
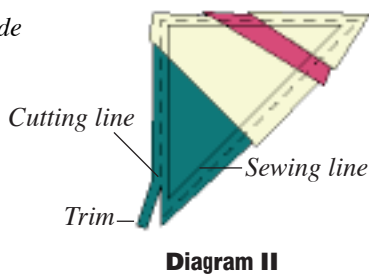
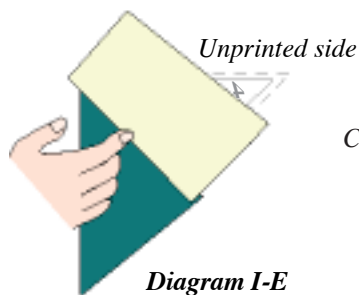
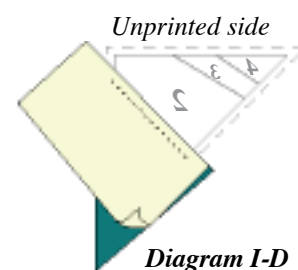
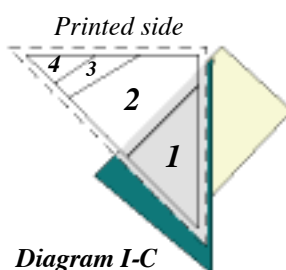
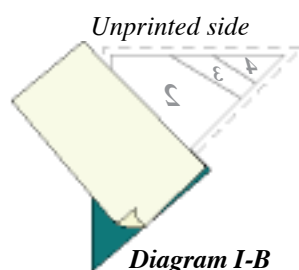
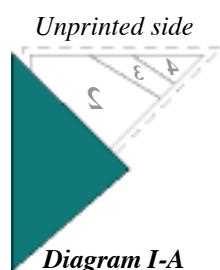


Diagram III

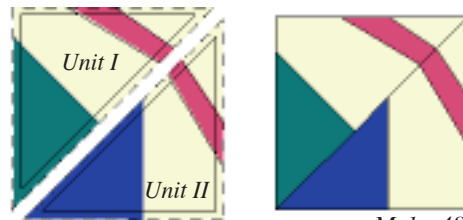

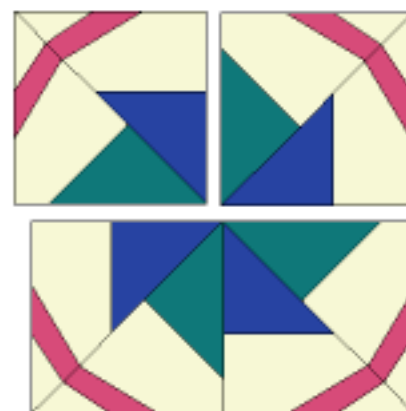
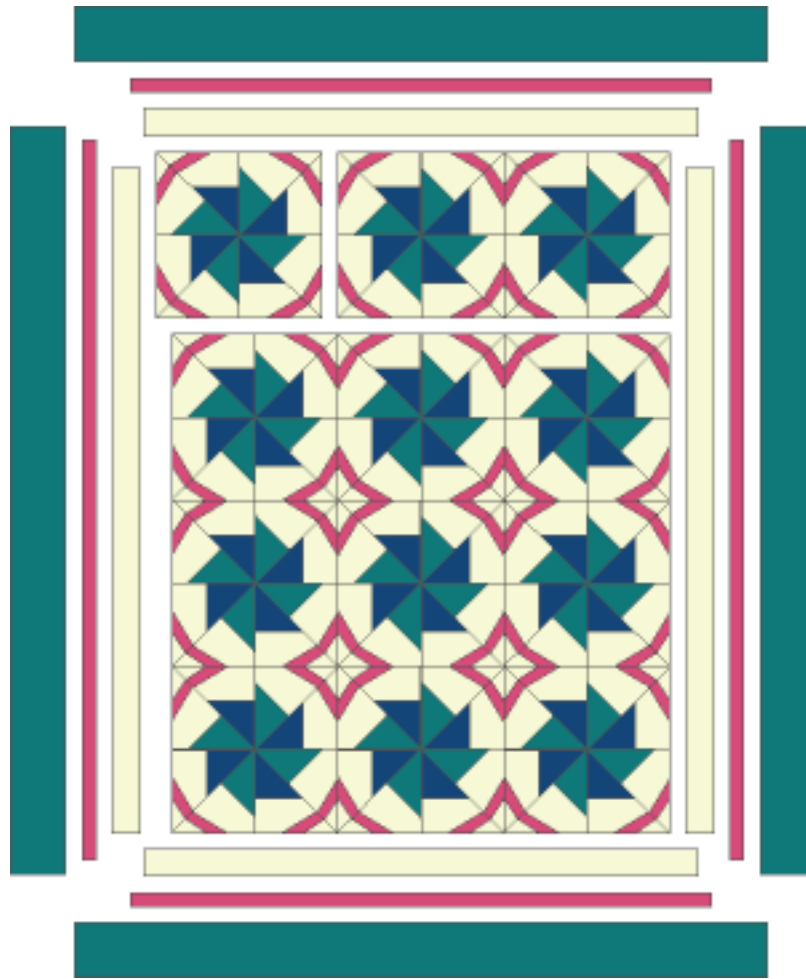
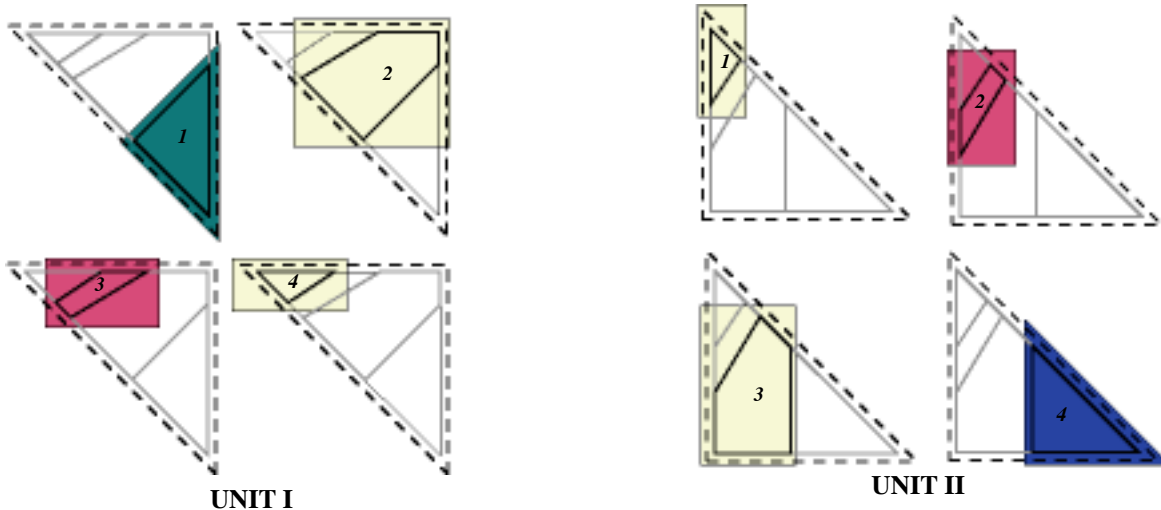


Diagram V
