

## Web Bonus: Flower Patch Throw Pillow

### Finished Pillow Size

14" x 14"

### shop

Pink wavy stripe (border)  
White/bright flower panel (center)  
Coordinating print (pillow back)  
Pillow form, 14" x 14"

See-through template plastic (optional)

\*A fat quarter is an 18" x 20-22" cut of fabric.

\*\*Yardage and cutting based on featured fabric; one 10½" flower square needed. If you purchased fabric to make the quilt, you'll have 2 flowers left over with which to make pillows.

### cut

#### (in order listed)

Pink wavy stripe

2 strips 2½" x 14½", cut on lengthwise grain  
2 strips 2½" x 10½", cut on lengthwise grain

White/bright flower panel

1 square 10½" x 10½", fussy-cut centered on flower

Coordinating print

1 square 14½" x 14½"

### plan

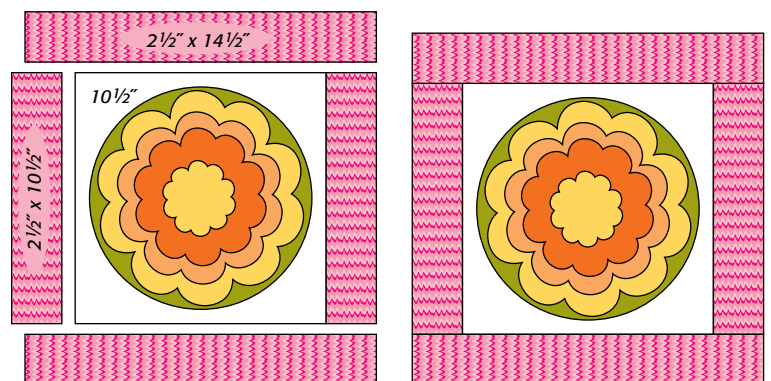
Make a super-quick pillow to accessorize your quilt or add cheer to any room using fabrics from the Fun Flowers collections by LakeHouse Dry Goods. To fussy-cut a square from the flower panel, cut a 10½" square of see-through template plastic; place template on fabric, centering on flower. Mark around edge of template and cut out.

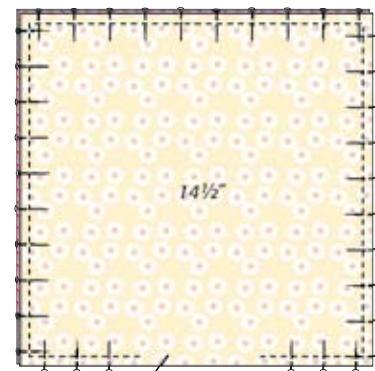
### sew

**1** Referring to **Diagram I**, stitch pink wavy stripe 10½" strips to sides of flower panel 10½" square. Sew pink 14½" strips to top and bottom to make pillow top.

**2** Layer pillow top and coordinating print 14½" square, right sides together (**Diagram II**). Sew around edges using ¼" seam, and leaving an opening for turning. Trim corners, turn right side out, and press. Insert pillow form. Hand-stitch opening closed.
