cut

- Yellow floral, tan dot, green mottle, **and** pink floral—**cut from each:**
 - 1 square 4" x 4"
 - Pale yellow solid
 - 4 strips 1 7/8" x 12"
 - Pink/cream bunny border stripe*
 - 2 strips 4 1/4" x 24", cut on lengthwise grain from jumping bunnies strip
 - 2 strips 4 1/4" x 24", cut lengthwise from sitting bunnies strip
 - Cream/pink floral
 - 4 strips 2 1/8" x 20"
 - Green/white dot
 - **3 strips 2 1/2" x width of fabric (binding)
 - 4 strips 1 3/8" x 20"
 - Bunny panel
 - 4 squares 3" x 3", centered on small bunny squares

**Cut first.

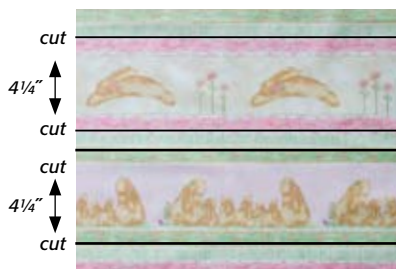
Yellow floral, tan dot, green mottle, and pink floral (blocks)	6" x 6" piece each	Green/white dot (pieced outer border, binding)	1/2 yd.
Pale yellow solid (inner border)	1/4 yd.	Bunny panel (outer border corners)	1 panel**
Pink/cream bunny border stripe (middle border)	7/8 yd.*	Backing and batting	28" x 28" piece each
Cream/pink floral (pieced outer border)	1/4 yd.		

*Yardage based on featured fabric.
**Bunny panel measures 24" x 44".
Leftover squares from making bed quilt are sufficient for doll quilt.

Note: Watch orientation of bunnies throughout.

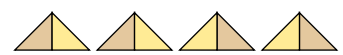
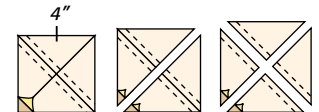
1 Draw 2 diagonal lines on wrong side of assorted 4" square. Place marked square on another 4" square, right sides together (**Diagram I**). Sew 1/4" seam on each side of 1 line. Cutting on unsewn line first, then on remaining drawn line, cut sewn square into quarters. Press open to make pieced triangles. Make 8 total.

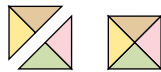
Fabrics from the Nana's Garden collection by Arlene Neely for Red Rooster Fabrics are key to the sweet feel of this adorable doll quilt. Cut border stripe strips carefully to ensure 2 sets of matching border strips.

Diagram I

Referring to **Diagram II**, stitch 2 pieced triangles together to make Hourglass Block. Make 4 total.



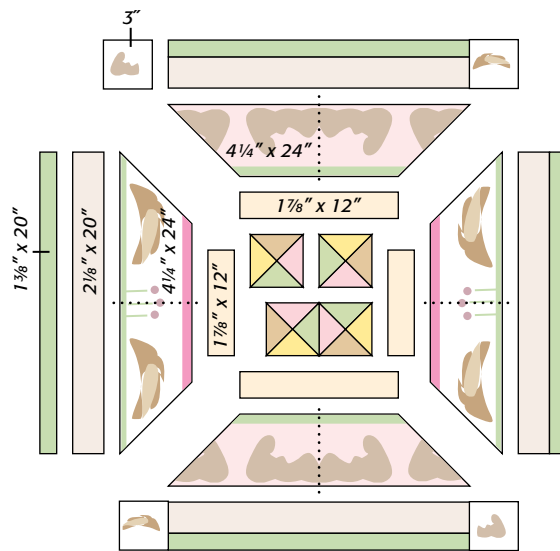

- 2 **Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** and **photo** for following steps. Stitch 2 rows of 2 Hourglass Blocks each. Sew rows together to make quilt center. Sew yellow solid 12" strips to sides; trim even with top/bottom. Add yellow 12" strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.
- 3 For help with mitered borders, go to quickquilts.com, and click on Lessons, Borders, then Mitered Borders. Starting and stopping 1/4" from quilt corners, center and sew jumping bunny 24" strips to sides and sitting bunny strips to top/bottom. Sew and trim mitered corners.
- 4 Stitch together 1 cream/pink floral and 1 green/white dot 20" strips. Make 4. Measure exact width of

quilt center (from raw edge to raw edge). Trim 2 cream/green strips to this measurement; sew 3" bunny squares to ends, watching orientation. Stitch remaining cream/green strips to sides of

quilt; trim even with top/bottom. Sew pieced strips to top/bottom.

- 5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Laura machine quilted all seams in the ditch. Bind with green/white dot.
