

Web Bonus: Fuchsia Furrows Table Runner

Skill Level

CONFIDENT BEGINNER

Finished Table Runner Size

18½ x 47½"

Note: Templates are at end of pattern.
Appliqué templates are printed without seam allowance.

Fabric Requirements

Cream small floral and cream large floral (pieced strips)	1 fat quarter* each
Fuchsia print (pieced strips, yo-yos)	¾ yd.
Gray circle print and cream string print (pieced strips, outer flowers)	1 fat quarter* each
Fuchsia texture (pieced strips, appliqué backgrounds)	¾ yd.
Lime solid (stems, leaves)	1 fat quarter*
Green solid (binding)	¾ yd.
Backing	1½ yds.
Batting size	26" x 54"
Bias bar, ¾" (optional)	

*A fat quarter is an 18" x 20-22" cut of fabric.

Planning

Fun pieced strips and cute appliqué flowers combine in this perky table runner. Flowers feature dimensional yo-yos for an extra cute finish.

Cutting Instructions

(cut first, before cutting appliqué)

Note: Cutting instructions for appliqué shapes are on templates at the end of pattern.

Cream small floral, fuchsia print, cream large floral, gray circle print, **and** cream string print—**cut from each:**

4 strips 1½" x 20-22"

Fuchsia texture

*2 strips 5½" x 52", pieced from 3 width of fabric (WOF) strips

7 strips 1½" x 8½"

Lime texture

**1 square 12" x 12" (for 1¼" x 80" bias-cut strip)

Green solid

4 strips 2½" x WOF (binding)

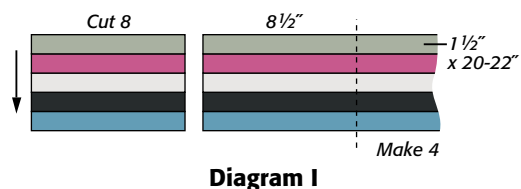
*Strips include extra length for trimming.

Piecing the Segments

1 Referring to **Diagram I**, sew together 1 each cream small floral, fuchsia print, cream large floral, gray circle print, and cream circle print 1½" x 20-22" strips to make strip set. Make 4. Press in direction of arrow. Cut into 8 segments 8½" wide.

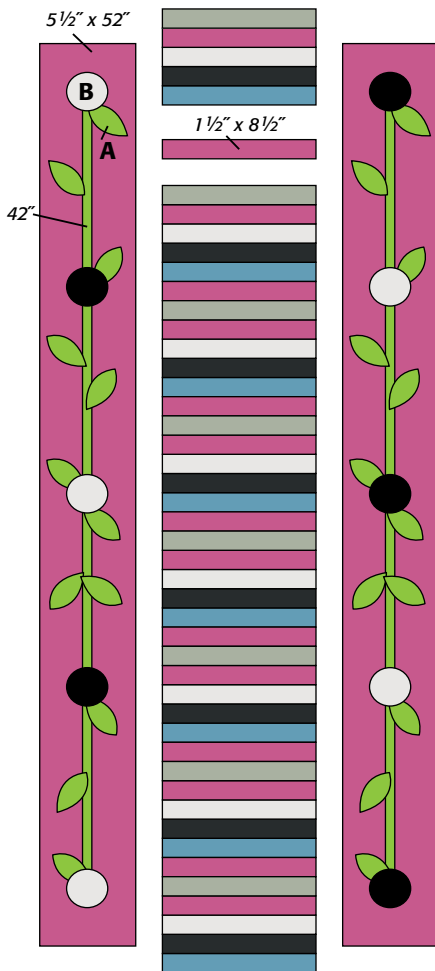


The pattern for the 46" x 60½" quilt is in the January/February 2014 issue of *McCall's Quilting*.

Assembling the Quilt Top

Note: Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps, watching orientation throughout.

2 Stitch pieced strip using segments and fuchsia $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, alternating.

3 Sew together pieced strip and fuchsia texture 52" strips, alternating and trimming fuchsia strips even after each addition.

4 Referring to **Diagram II**, fold lime $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 90" strip in half, wrong sides together. Stitch $\frac{3}{8}$ " from fold. Trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{8}$ ". Press tube flat, centering seam allowance on back so raw edge isn't visible from front. Using $\frac{3}{8}$ " bias bar makes pressing faster and easier. Cut tube into 2 stems 42" long.

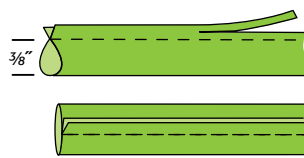

5 Position stems and A-B. Appliqué in place.

Quilting and Finishing

6 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with green solid.

7 Make 10 Yo-Yos; (see **Making Fabric Yo-Yos**, at right). Tack yo-yos to B circles.

Making Fabric Yo-Yos

Fold $\frac{1}{4}$ " to wrong side of C circle. Using knotted thread, sew running stitch approximately $\frac{1}{8}$ " from folded edge.

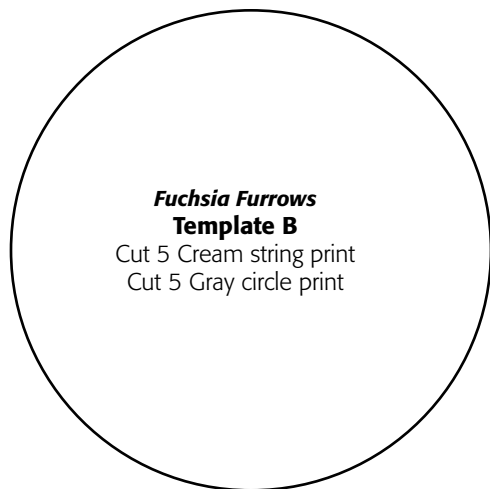


Stitch all the way around C circle, leaving thread end for gathering.



Draw up gathering thread to make yo-yo. Take a few small stitches in yo-yo to secure.





This box measures 2 inches wide by 1 inch high. Use this as a guide for accuracy when printing the Pattern Section.
