Finished Quilt Size
32 1/2" x 57 1/2"

Note: Optional star template is given without seam allowance.



Fabric Requirements

Black batik (sky, pieced border)	1 3/4 yds.
Assorted jewel-tone batiks (roofs, pieced border)	1-1 1/4 yds, total
Assorted medium batiks (houses)	1/2 -3/4 yd. total
Medium green batik (grass)	1/2 yd.
Dark gold batik (doors)	8" x 10" piece
Light gold batik (door)	3" x 4" piece
Multicolor stripe (inner border, binding)	3/4 yd.
Silver metallic texture (optional stars)	8" x 8" piece
Backing	2 yds.
Batting size	Twin

Planning

This basic version of Cheryl's pattern can be easily adapted to any fabric theme. Arrange all sky and house patches and pieced roofs on a design surface before beginning Step 3 assembly.

Cutting Instructions

Black batik

- *2 strips 3 1/4" x 20 1/4"
- *6 strips 1 1/2" x 20 1/4"
- *2 strips 5 1/2" x 15"
- *2 strips 4 1/2" x 14 5/8"
- *2 strips 4 1/2" x 14"
- *2 strips 4 1/2" x 12 5/8"
- *1 strip 5" x 10 1/2"
- 4 squares 3" x 3"
- 14 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 30 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" ☐
- 4 squares 4" x 4"

Assorted jewel-tone batiks

- cut 3 matching sets of:**
 - *2 squares 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" ☐
 - 2 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- cut 1 matching set of:**
 - *2 squares 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" ☐
 - 2 rectangles 3" x 5 1/2"
- cut 1 matching set of:**
 - *2 squares 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" ☐
 - 1 rectangle 2 1/2" x 5"

Assorted medium batiks

- cut 1 set of:**
 - 2 matching rectangles 4 1/2" x 4 3/4"
- cut 1 set of:**
 - 2 matching rectangles 3 1/4" x 5 1/2"
- cut 1 set of:**
 - 2 matching rectangles 4 1/2" x 6 1/8"
- cut 1 set of:**
 - 2 matching rectangles 4 1/8" x 4 1/2"
- also cut:**
 - 1 rectangle 5" x 8 1/4"

Medium green batik

- 1 strip 5 3/4" x 50 1/2", pieced from 2 width of fabric (WOF) strips

Dark gold batik

- **8 rectangles 1 3/4" x 2 3/8"

Light gold batik

- **1 rectangle 2" x 3 1/8"

Multicolor stripe

- *6 strips 2 1/2" x WOF (binding)
- *2 strips 1" x 50 1/2", pieced from 3 WOF strips
- 2 strips 1" x 25 1/2"

Silver metallic texture

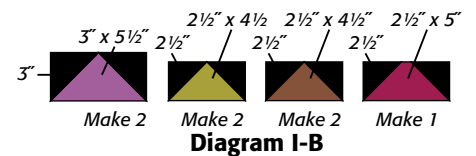
- **9 Template A

*Cut first.

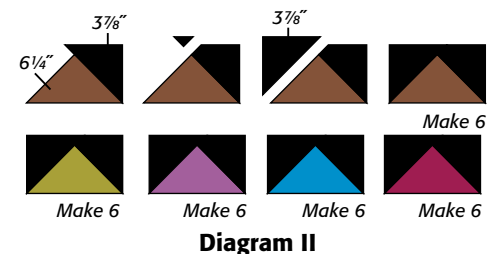
**Add 1/4" appliqué turn-under allowance to all sides if desired.

Piecing the Roofs and Border Rectangles

1 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of black 2 1/2" square. Referring to **Diagram I-A**, place marked square on assorted jewel-tone 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle, right sides together, aligning raw edges. Sew on marked line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Press open. Repeat on opposite end of rectangle to make roof. Make 2 matching. In same manner, make remaining roofs in fabrics, sizes, and quantities shown in **Diagram I-B**.



2 Referring to **Diagram II**, stitch together assorted jewel-tone 6 1/4" quarter-square triangle and black 3 7/8" half-square triangle. Press open; trim black triangle even with jewel-tone triangle. Sew 2nd black triangle to unit; press open to complete border rectangle. Make 6. Repeat to make remaining border rectangles as shown. You will have 2 triangles left over of each jewel-tone batik.



Village Assembly

- 3** Stitch house rectangles, pieced roofs, and black strips together to make 9 house strips total as shown in **Diagram III**. Sew black 20 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips and house strips together in order shown to make village.

Quilt Top Assembly and Appliqué

Note: Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps.

- 4** Stitch green 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to bottom of village. Position door rectangles and optional stars; appliqué in place.
- 5** Sew 5 border rectangles together end to end, watching color placement. Add multicolor stripe 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to jewel-tone side to make side border. Make 2; sew to sides of quilt center. Sew 10 border rectangles together end to end, watching color placement. Add stripe 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to jewel-tone side. Sew black 4" squares to ends to complete top/bottom border. Make 2; sew to top/bottom.

Quilting and Finishing

- 6** Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with multicolor stripe.

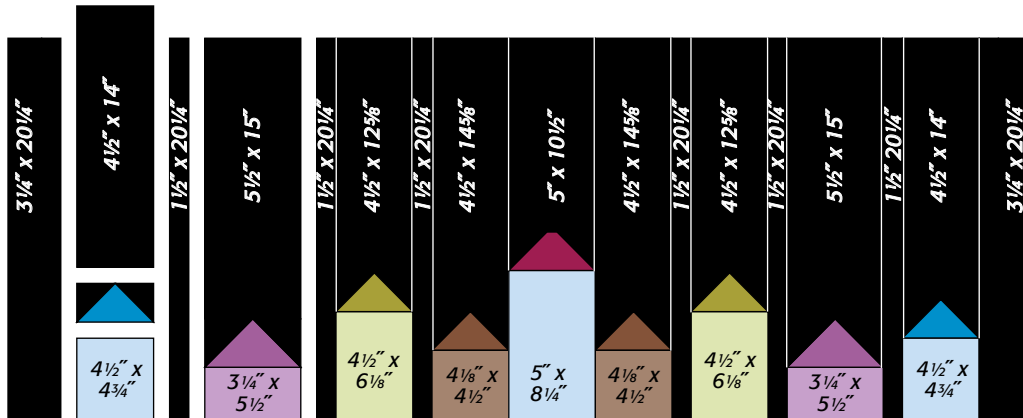
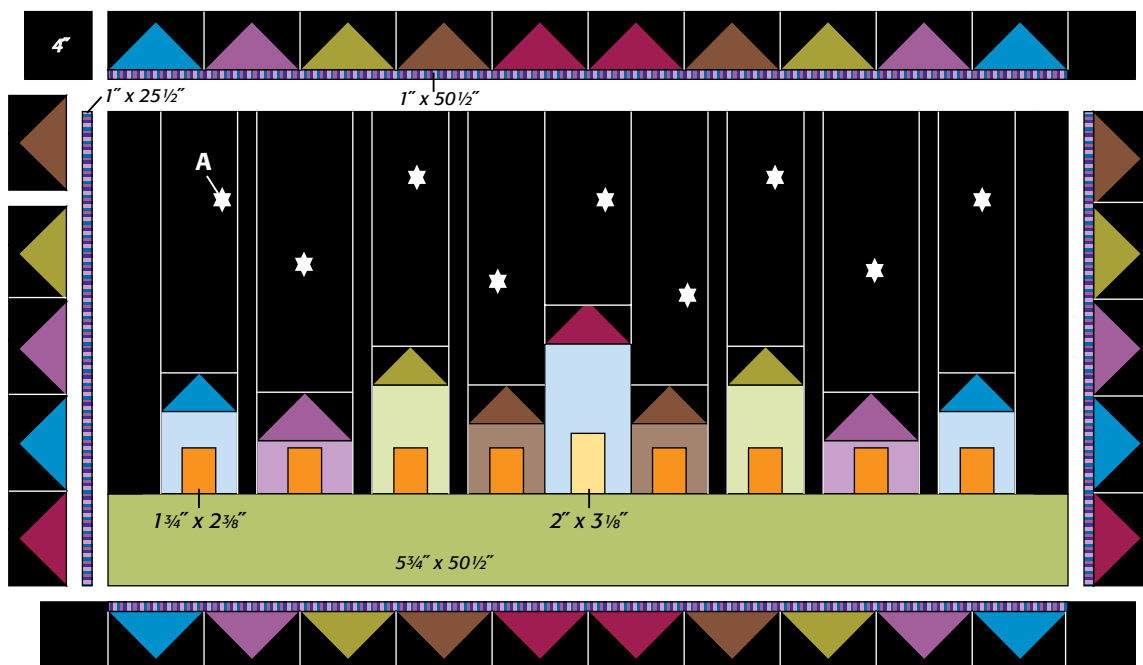


Diagram III
