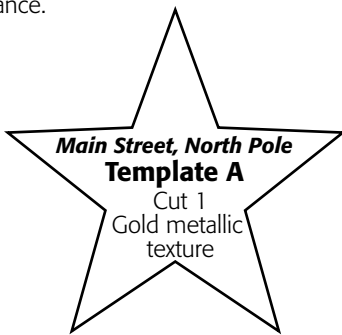


# Home for Hannukah Web Bonus: Main Street, North Pole

Finished Quilt Size  
**32 1/2" x 57 1/2"**

**Note:** Star template is given without seam allowance.



## Fabric Requirements

Light blue print (sky)	1 1/8 yds.
Dark green print <b>and</b> medium green print (roofs, houses, pieced border)	3/8 yd. <b>each</b>
Medium brown print <b>and</b> dark brown print (roofs)	8" x 8" piece <b>each</b>
Dark gold print (roofs, houses, door)	1 fat eighth*
Red print (borders, doors)	3/4 yd.
Red/white diagonal stripe (poles, binding)	3/4 yd.
Gold/red/green print (Santa's house)	1 fat eighth*
White print (snow)	1/2 yd.
Gold metallic texture (star)	3" x 3" piece
Backing	2 yds.
Batting size	Twin

\*A fat eighth is a 9" x 20-22" cut of fabric.



## Planning

Add this sweet view of Santa's street to your holiday decorations. Arrange all sky, pole, and house patches and pieced roofs on a design surface before beginning Step 3 assembly.

## Cutting Instructions

- ☒ = cut in half twice diagonally
- ☑ = cut in half diagonally

### Light blue print

- \*2 strips 2 1/4" x 20 1/4"
- \*2 strips 5 1/2" x 15"
- \*2 strips 1 1/2" x 15"
- \*2 strips 4 1/2" x 14 5/8"
- \*2 strips 1 1/2" x 14 5/8"
- \*2 strips 4 1/2" x 14"
- \*2 strips 1 1/2" x 14"
- 2 strips 4 1/2" x 12 5/8"
- 2 strips 1 1/2" x 12 5/8"
- 1 strip 5" x 10 1/2"
- 14 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- 4 squares 3" x 3"

### Dark green print

- \*4 squares 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" ☒
- 2 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- 2 rectangles 3 1/4" x 5 1/2"

### Medium brown print

- 2 rectangles 3" x 5 1/2"

### Dark gold print

- 2 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
- 2 rectangles 4 1/2" x 4 3/4"
- \*\*1 rectangle 2" x 3 1/8"

### Dark brown print

- 2 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

### Medium green print

- \*4 squares 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" ☒
- 1 rectangle 2 1/2" x 5"
- 2 rectangles 4 1/2" x 6 1/8"

### Red print

- \*2 strips 1" x 50 1/2", pieced from 3 width of fabric (WOF) strips
- \*2 strips 1" x 25 1/2"
- 30 squares 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" ☑
- \*\*8 rectangles 1 3/4" x 2 3/8"
- 4 squares 4" x 4"

### Red/white diagonal stripe

- \*6 strips 2 1/2" x WOF (binding)
- 2 strips 1 1/2" x 6 3/4"
- 2 strips 1 1/2" x 5 3/4"
- 2 strips 1 1/2" x 8 1/8"
- 2 strips 1 1/2" x 6 1/8"

### Gold/red/green print

- 2 rectangles 4 1/8" x 4 1/2"
- 1 rectangle 5" x 8 1/4"

### White print

- 1 strip 5 3/4" x 50 1/2", pieced from 2 WOF strips

### Gold metallic texture

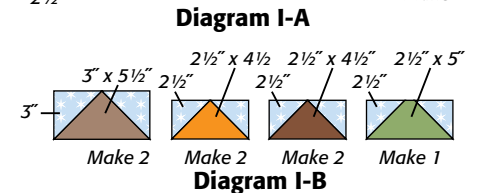
- \*\*1 Template A

\*Cut first.

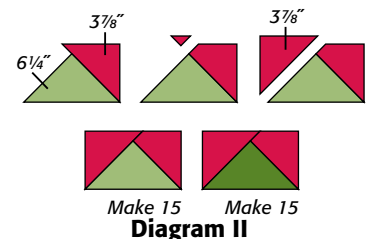
\*\*Add 1/4" appliqué turn-under allowance to all sides if desired.

## Piecing the Roofs and Border Rectangles

**1** Draw diagonal line on wrong side of light blue 2 1/2" square. Referring to **Diagram I-A**, place marked square on dark green 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle, right sides together, aligning raw edges. Sew on marked line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Press open. Repeat on opposite end of rectangle to make dark green roof. Make 2. In same manner, make remaining roofs in fabrics, sizes, and quantities shown in **Diagram I-B**.



**2** Referring to **Diagram II**, stitch together medium green 6 1/4" quarter-square triangle and red 3 7/8" half-square triangle. Press open; trim red triangle even with green triangle. Sew 2nd red triangle to unit; press open to complete border rectangle. Make 15. Make 15 using dark green quarter-square triangles. You will have 1 triangle left over of each green print.



## Village Assembly

**3** Sew red/white diagonal stripe and light blue  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips together to make 8 pole strips total as shown in **Diagram III**. Stitch house rectangles, pieced roofs, and blue strips together to make 9 house strips total. Sew blue  $20\frac{1}{4}$ " strips, pole strips, and house strips together in order shown to make village.

## Quilt Top Assembly and Appliqué

**Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following steps.

- 4** Stitch white  $50\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to bottom of village. Position door rectangles and star; appliqué in place.
- 5** Sew 5 border rectangles together end to end, alternating. Add red  $25\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to green side to make side border. Make 2; sew to sides of quilt center. Sew 10 border rectangles together end to end, alternating. Add red  $50\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to green side. Sew red 4" squares to ends to complete top/bottom border. Make 2; sew to top/bottom.

## Quilting and Finishing

**6** Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with red/white diagonal stripe.

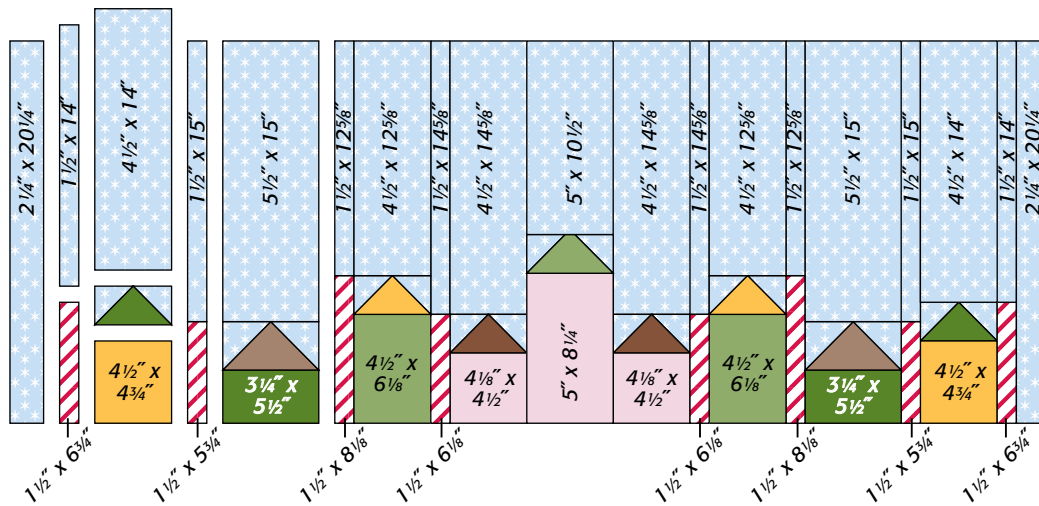
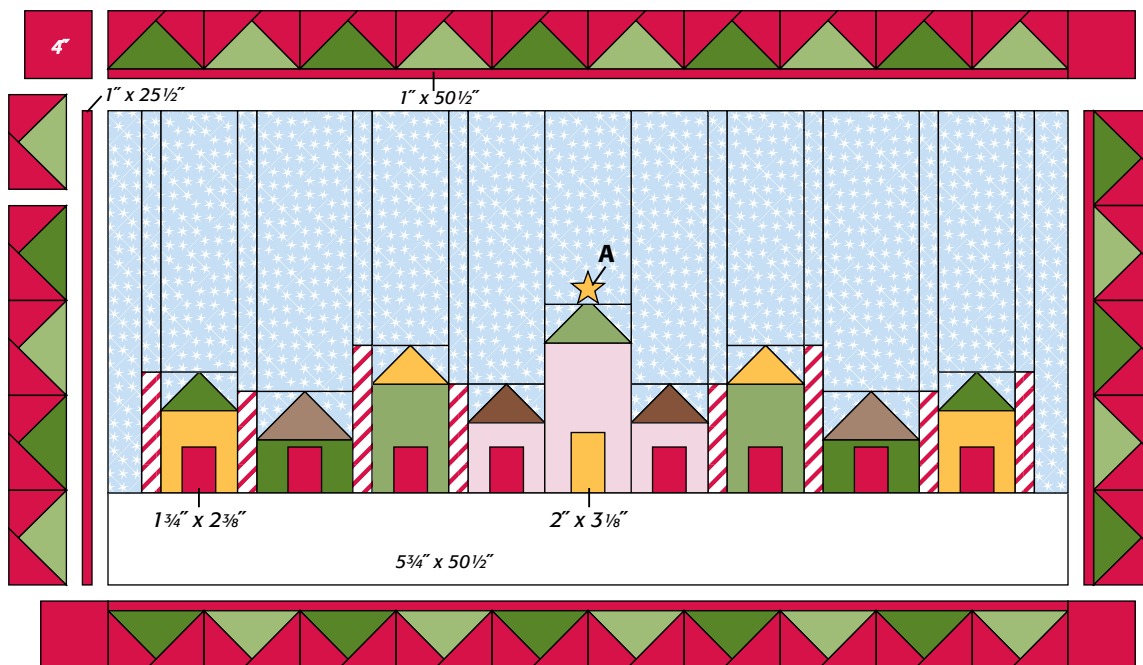


Diagram III
