Finished Pillow Size
14" x 14"

Number of Blocks and Finished Size
1 Framed Squares Block
14" x 14"

plan

This quick and easy throw pillow can be made in a jiffy! If making the featured quilt, you may want to piece an extra block for a pillow when making the quilt.

shop

- #1 assorted print/floral 1 fat quarter*
- (block) quarter*
- #2 assorted print/floral 1 fat eighth**
- (block) eighth**
- Backing 3/8 yd.
- Pillow form, 14" x 14"
- *A fat quarter is an 18" x 20-22" cut of fabric.
- **A fat eighth is a 9" x 20-22" cut of fabric.

cut

- #1 assorted print/floral
 - *2 strips 2 1/2" x 14 1/2"
 - *2 strips 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"
 - *2 strips 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"
 - 2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
 - #2 assorted print/floral
 - *2 strips 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"
 - *2 strips 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"
 - 1 square 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
 - Backing
 - 2 rectangles 9 1/2" x 14 1/2"
- *Cut first.

sew

- 1** Referring to **Diagram I**, stitch squares and strips together in order shown to make 1 Framed Squares Block.

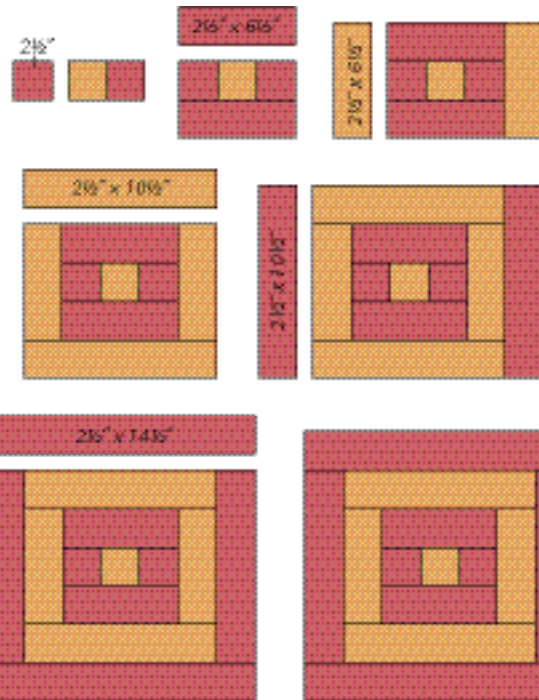

- 2** To hem backing rectangle, fold and press 3/8" to wrong side of 1 long edge twice (**Diagram II**). Topstitch 1/8" from inner folded edge. Make 2.

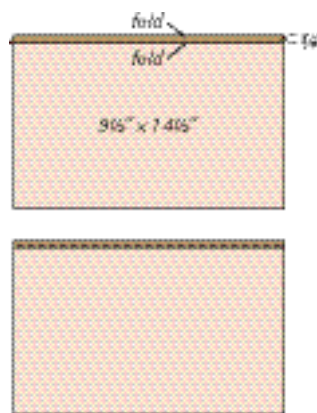

- 3** Referring to **Diagram III**, layer Framed Squares Block and hemmed rectangles, right sides together and raw edges aligned, with hemmed edges overlapping in center back. Using 1/4" seam allowance, stitch together on all sides.

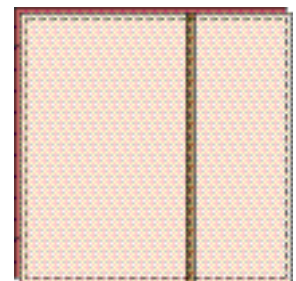

- 4** Turn right side out and insert pillow form.
