Plan

Stylish prints combined in a sophisticated color scheme take this uncomplicated patchwork to elegant heights. Consider using a design wall or other flat surface to arrange your blocks and sashing strips before assembling your quilt. Use an accurate ¼" seam allowance throughout to ensure all elements of the quilt fit together well; visit McCallsQuilting.com and click on Lessons, then How to Make a Quilt for a great tutorial.

Assorted turquoise, lime, teal, and olive prints (blocks, pieced sashing, pieced binding)	6½-7½ yds.
total	
White solid (pieced sashing)	4½ yds.
Backing (piece widthwise)	8⅞ yds.
Batting size	102" x 114"

Cut

(in order listed)

Assorted turquoise, lime, teal, and olive prints—**cut a total of:**

24 strips 2½" x 20-22" (binding)

224 rectangles 4½" x 6½"

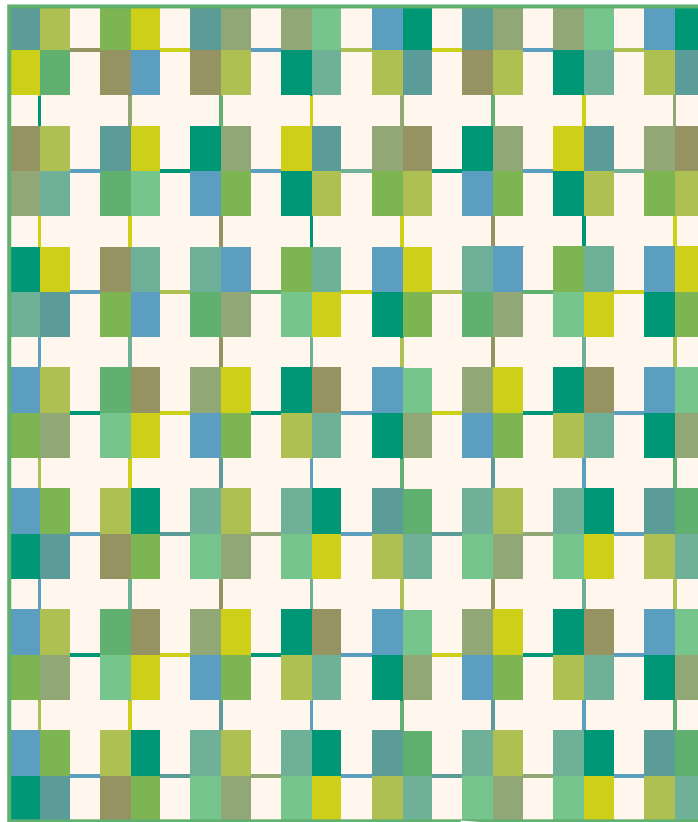
97 strips 1" x 4½"

White solid

42 strips 4½" x 12"

98 rectangles 4½" x 6¼"

12 rectangles 4¼" x 4½"

Sew

1 Referring to **Diagram I**, stitch 4 assorted print $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles together to make a Four-Patch Block. Make 56 total.

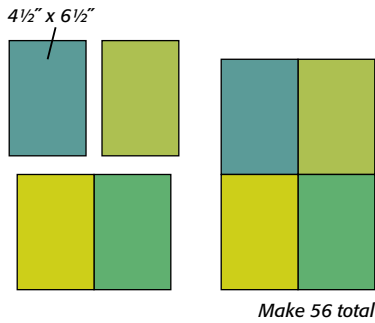

2 Sew 2 white $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $6\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles to assorted print 1 " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to make pieced sashing strip (**Diagram II**). Make 49 total.

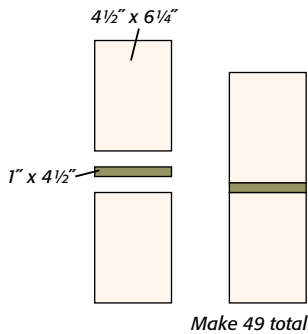

3 Note: Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for this step. Stitch 7 block rows of 8 blocks and 7 pieced sashing strips each. Sew together 2 white $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, 8 assorted print 1 " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, and 7 white 12 " strips to make sashing row. Make 6. Sew rows together, alternating.

4 Layer, baste, and quilt.

5 Join assorted print $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20-22" binding strips with diagonal seams (**Diagram III**). Bind with pieced strip.

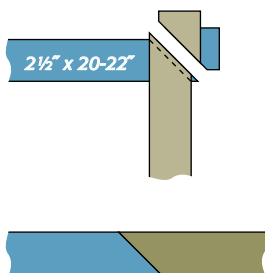
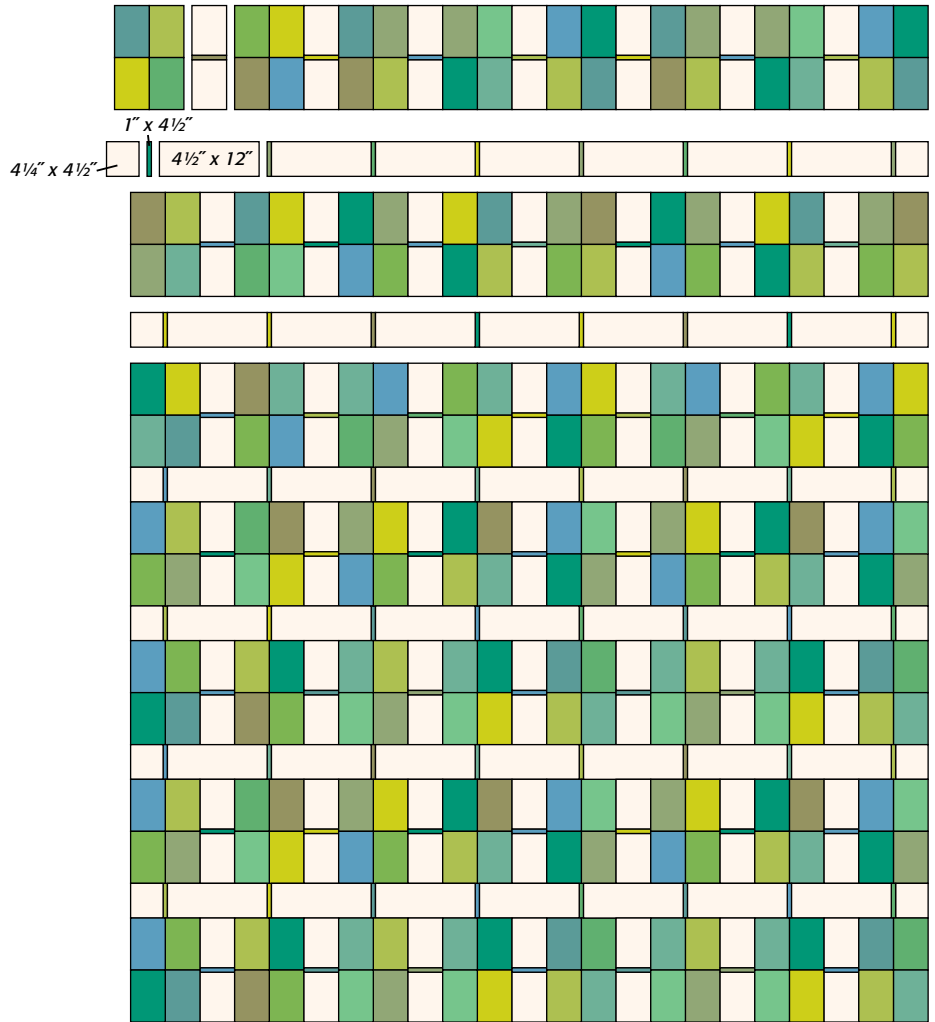


Diagram III
